

## Rules for Students on the Bus

- **Bus Driver/and or Administration:** Must be obeyed at all times. The driver has the authority to assign seats and make new rules, if necessary.
- **Stay Seated:** Remain in your seat with your back against the seat and bottom on it, facing forward, for the entire trip.
- **Keep it Inside:** Keep your hands, arms, and head inside the bus at all times.
- **Clear the Aisles:** Keep your feet and bags out of the aisle to ensure it remains clear.
- **No Disruptions:** Do not shout, throw items, or otherwise disturb the driver or other riders.
- **Personal Space:** Respect others' personal space and property.
- **Safety Equipment:** Do not tamper with bus controls or safety equipment, including emergency exits.
- **Cell Phones:** Silent Mode-Headphones strongly encouraged when listening to your personal electronic devices.
- **Language:** No foul language.
- **Trash:** Trash in the trash can as you exit. If you bring it on the bus, it is your responsibility to remove it from the bus.
- **Gum:** No gum chewing on the bus.
- **Food:** Food and drinks may create a choking hazard while riding a bus.
- **No inappropriate actions** between students.
- **No tobacco or drug** use of any kind.
- **All school rules** must be followed per the Student Handbook.
- **Seating:** Middle school students will sit in the front of the bus and high school students will sit in the back of the bus. There will be a clear separation of seating.
